Lesson Plan: Comparative and Superlative Adjectives. Start the lesson by explaining the definition of a comparative adjective through writing the definition and examples on the whiteboard.

### Lesson Plan for Comparative and Superlative Adjectives

Lesson Outline . Activate students' awareness of the comparative and superlative by comparing three objects of your choice. For example, compare life in the US, the country where you are teaching and another country of your choice. Ask students questions based on what you have told them.

### Comparative and Superlative Forms Lesson Plan

They are trying to choose food items that are tastier and cheaper than others. In this lesson plan, adaptable for grades K-8, students identify and classify comparative adjectives and adverbs, justify preferences with evidence, and explain and illustrate a figure of speech.

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construction of comparatives from their base adjectives (+ -er) and include some spelling changes for some adjectives (e.g. doubling the consonant of adjectives such as big/bigger and for adding -ier for adjectives ending in -y such as friendly/friendlier).
